I am pleased to report that I continue to be invited to speak at conferences on the work which I did during my MA thesis project at the Atlantic University. For this, I worked with near-death experiencers (NDErs) from different parts of the world, to help them find what it was they had come back into physical life to do. They all say they knew they had to return to complete the mission they had promised to fulfill, but many of them did not know what this was. These are the ones I felt moved to help. Using transpersonal tools, I designed a 6-week course for them which enabled them to

discover their mission. The course had an 83% success rate, which was regarded as excellent. The near-death experiencers asked me to get my course into the public domain, so I wrote a book and put the entire course in that, along with up-to-date medical research and NDE history, plus post-course
